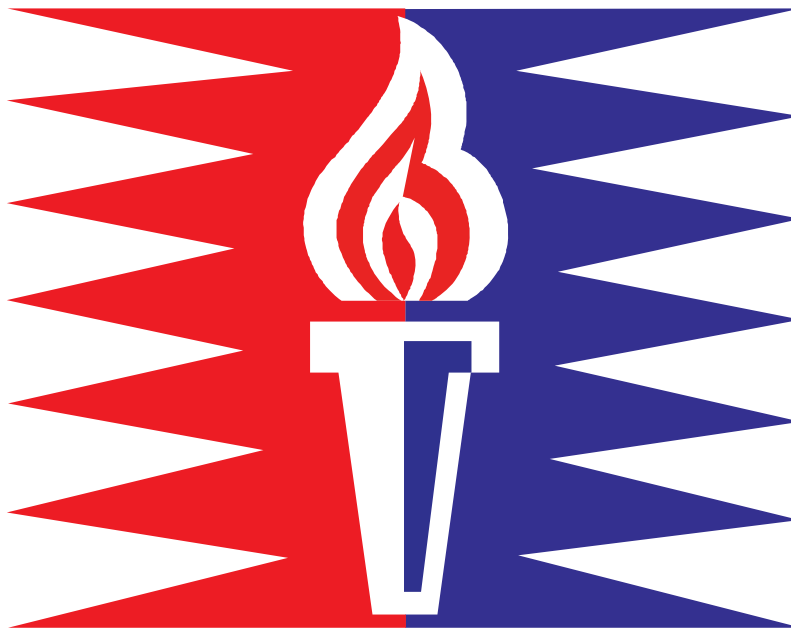

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Call your local senior center or ***Dearborn Senior Center (313) 943-2412***.

**Eligibility:** Western Wayne County men and women 50 years of age or older.

**Registration:** Registration, Event Payment, Waiver and Medical Information forms must be completed. Submit your forms to your local Senior Center by Friday, July 16, 2010. If you do not have a Senior Program in your area, call the City of Dearborn Senior Services ***(313)943-2412***. No late entries will be accepted, no event changes will be permitted, and no on-site registrations will be accepted. A non-refundable registration fee of \$5 will be charged to all participants, plus a \$5 fee for bowling, a \$12 fee for golf and a \$2 fee for each of the other events. (swimming and tennis is only one \$2 fee for all categories). Dance fee of \$10 includes entry to the Tango, Waltz and Swing competition and Dinner. Dance Contest Dinner fee is \$5.

**T-Shirts:** Your \$5 registration fee will include a t-shirt. Please state your size on the registration form. Your t-shirt is your admission to the breakfast and all events in which you are registered. **PLEASE WEAR YOUR T-SHIRT. If a t-shirt size is not marked on the registration form, the participant will receive an XL.** Additional t-shirt cost is \$10.

**Team Events:** Team members must be individually registered, and the team name listed on the event payment form in the space provided. For tennis, volleyball, pickle ball please specify a partner, if possible.

**Awards:** Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in each age category and gender for most events. See individual event rules for details.

**Confirmation of registration:** Senior Coordinators will receive a confirmation list with all the events in which their center's participants are entered. Senior participants should check with their Coordinator to receive a copy of their events registered, rules, and maps for each event, t-shirts, banquet tickets and any additional information they may need.

**Banquet:** Recognition of Olympic participants, medal winners, and sponsors will be Friday, August 20, 2010 at the Awards Banquet held at the *Ford Community and Performing Arts Center*. The banquet is open to all Olympic participants and adult guests. Tickets are \$12 per person. Please check the appropriate box on your registration form if you wish to attend the banquet.

**Equipment:** Equipment will be provided for all events with the exception of golf, bowling, tennis, pickle ball and biking.

**Inclement Weather and Insufficient Registration:** In case of inclement weather or insufficient registration, the Western Wayne County Senior Olympic Committee reserves the right to cancel or postpone events.
